

TIME FOR ME TV, LLC – SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

I. GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Time For Me TV, LLC the producer (“Time For Me TV” or “Producer”) of television commercials featuring independently produced videos (“Content”) by members of the public (“Content Providers”). Only videos conforming to Time For Me TV, LLC - Network & Cable Broadcast Standards and Practices based on Producer’s judgment, as they determine in their sole discretion, will be eligible for consideration. If the Content is unable to be aired due to forces beyond Producer’s control, such as cancellation, forces *majeure*, or a labor dispute, Producer reserves the right to terminate, suspend and/or modify the Content broadcast.

II. PROCEDURES

Time For Me TV, LLC will place content on television that adheres to these rules, however, television stations have the ultimate say on what will and won’t be placed on their stations. This is not to say that only the best submissions will be placed in a commercial. It means: although your submission may be acceptable to Time For Me TV, it may be deemed unacceptable to television stations or it may need to air on “Late Night” television.

The Following are a brief list of the criteria for successful submissions:

1. Clients must purchase a minimum of 8 seconds and a maximum of 54 seconds. Time purchases and length will coincide with the available/selected time slots in each television/cable bracket.
2. We cannot accept emailed submissions due to the degradation of video quality. Submissions must be made in beta or digital product with applicable time code. As the broadcaster retains the right to not air “poor quality” transmissions, higher quality submissions are preferable. If submitting videos digitally, the recommended specifications are 30 Frames Per Second with 720x486 Resolution. Acceptable file formats are: .WMV, .AVI, .MOV and .MPG up to 300 MB. If you are mailing your submission, all consumer video formats are acceptable (VHS, 8MM, Hi-8, digital video). Videos transferred to DVD or CD-ROM will be accepted provided they meet eligibility and broadcast requirements. 8MM film transferred to videotape is also accepted. Digital chips will not be accepted.
3. Clients will be billed only when their submission is deemed acceptable in content by the broadcaster, slated for the requested time slot, passes all media quality tests, and all required documentation has been processed (e.g. releases, copyrights, licenses).
4. Submissions containing the following will not be accepted: racially motivated subject matter, offensive viewpoints, nudity, vulgar language, and vulgar displays of a sexual or violent nature. Submissions violating FCC and Communication policies.
5. Copy-written and privately owned songs, music and movie scenes must be licensed from the various owner(s) and require written permission. Submissions omitting this requirement will therefore not be considered for broadcast in a Time For Me TV commercial. All submissions are guaranteed by the submitting entity and the submitting entity indemnifies and holds harmless Producer for any violations, material or otherwise.
6. Submissions containing persons shall require each person to sign a release form or submission will require editing at the expense of the client. Underage children must have a signed consent from their respective guardian. All content providers will ensure that all applicable child labor laws and union/guild rules are adhered to and fulfilled. Content Providers expressly agree to account to all unions/guilds with an interest in submitted Content.

7. Accepted submissions will be assigned an “Actual Paid Client” number or APC# that will act as client contact number. This will be the number used on all Content Provider submissions, correspondence, and filing. No client contact information such as company logos, branding, phone numbers, email addresses, signs or any other forms of identification other than APC# will be displayed or spoken on any submission. Failure to adhere to this request will result in editing fees to be incurred by client.
8. Submissions must be original and not an infringement on or against another person, business or agency.
9. Preemption is a possibility for any commercial at the discretion of the respective broadcaster. If a Content Provider commercial is preempted, Content Providers who do not air in that commercial will be offered a full refund or the opportunity to have their submission rescheduled. ‘Time For Me TV, LLC.’ will not be held responsible for a commercial being preempted for any reason.
10. The work performed by Content Provider shall constitute a specially ordered and commissioned work for hire as that term is used in the Copyright Act of 1976, as amended. To the extent it is held not to be a work for hire, Content Provider hereby assigns all its right, title and interest in all work performed and services rendered, including written and other materials, to COMPANY. Producer and Content Provider expressly agree that every result of Content Provider’s services rendered hereunder shall be owned solely and absolutely by Producer, including every right of copyright, for any and every purpose whatsoever without limitation or restriction in perpetuity. No submissions will be returned.

or submit home video on the Time For Me TV site on by following the instructions on the website. Videos will be reviewed on an ongoing basis.

12. If submitting by mail with a completed Submission Form (Attached). Content Providers should include their address, telephone number, and a brief written description of the videos being submitted.
13. All submissions become the sole property of Producer and may be used in any manner in all media. Producer reserves the right to destroy all videos. Producer is not responsible for lost, damaged or misdirected videos under any circumstances. Please keep a copy of your submission. Producer is not responsible for Internet system and hardware failures; delayed, incomplete or unsuccessful transmission of video or other entry information; technical malfunctions of any kind; human error; information loss and downtime; or any costs, losses, liability or damages resulting from any such failures.
14. Content Provider understands and agrees his/her video submission may receive exposure on various broadcast stations and may be subjected to comments and popularity ratings from the public at large. Producer is not responsible for any critical or derogatory remarks posted by the public pertaining to an entrant or an entrant’s video.
15. Producer reserves the right to edit and/or alter any submission.

16. Producer reserves the right to amend these submission terms and conditions at any time and Producer will notify Content Provider of changes. The rules in effect at whatever time the submission is entered will apply regardless of submission date.
17. Producer may, in its sole discretion, take whatever measures it deems necessary or appropriate to preserve the reputation and brand of Time For Me TV, LLC.

III. ELIGIBILITY

1. Content Submissions are open only to legal residents of the 50 United States and D.C. and Canada, excluding Quebec. Void in Quebec, Guam, Puerto Rico, U.S. Virgin Islands and other U.S. territories, and where prohibited or restricted by law.
2. Producer reserves the right to at any time implement new eligibility criteria and/or modify existing eligibility criteria, including, without limitation, geographical and age restrictions.
3. Content Provider must be eighteen (18) years of age or older as of the date of entry. Written parental consent will be required for persons under 18 (or who are not of the age of majority in their state of domicile) before their submissions will be considered.
4. Videos must not have been broadcast on national television previously. After submission of your content, it must be exclusive to Time For Me TV, LLC and you must be able to grant to Producer all rights set forth in the Releases. If your submitted video was posted on an Internet website(s) prior to submission to Producer, you must make every reasonable attempt to remove your submitted video from such websites at the time you submit your video to Producer. In the event you are unable to do so, or if your video has been widely disseminated and/or viewed via the Internet, Producer reserves the right to disqualify your submission at any time. However, Producer is under no obligation to take any action in this regard.
5. Content Provider whose videos are chosen for inclusion in a program must sign a Release and Indemnity in the form presented attesting, among other things, to the fact that they are the rightful owners of the submitted videos and that the video may be submitted and broadcast, and ownership transferred to Producer, without obtaining permission from or making any payment to any third party. All persons appearing in the video(s) must sign consent forms and/or Releases (which shall, among other things, grant to Producer the right to use such person's name, voice and likeness in any manner including, without limitation, for programming, promotional and advertising purposes) before the submission can be eligible for prize awards. A custodial parent or legal guardian must sign the consent/Release form for minors. Failure to provide requested Releases and/or consents will result in disqualification of entrant. A copy of these forms can be provided by Producer upon written request. Notwithstanding the foregoing, and without limitation of the rights granted to Producer, the submission of a video constitutes the Content Provider's permission to use the video and the name, voice and likeness of the Content Provider, as well as the Content Provider's representation that he/she has obtained all necessary permissions and approvals to use the video and the name, voice and likeness of all persons appearing in the video, in and in connection with the program and all exploitations thereof or otherwise, including, without limitation, for programming, advertising and promotion purposes, in all media now known or hereinafter created.
6. Each submission must be solely the original work of Content Provider.
7. Each Content Provider represents that his/her submission does not infringe on any third party's copyrighted material, trademark or other intellectual property rights, or privacy or publicity rights.

8. By submitting an entry, each entrant agrees to release, discharge, defend and hold harmless Time For Me TV, LLC and their respective parent, subsidiary and affiliated companies and their respective licensees, assigns, officers, directors, employees, agents and representatives from and against any claim, expense or liability arising from or related to submission, exhibition or exploitation of the entry, participation in this program (or any related programs), appearance on the program, and/or acceptance or use of any prize. All Content Providers must sign all consent forms, general releases and other documentation in the form provided by Producer or be eliminated from consideration. Releases will include, among other things, a statement that the videos were the exclusive property of the Content Provider(s) at the time they were submitted. Releases must be obtained from all identifiable persons depicted in videos. Parent or guardian must sign the consent/release form for minors.

9. Each Content Provider acknowledges and agrees that his/her submission may or may not receive exposure in the media, that competing submissions may receive more or less exposure in the media, and that Producer, Network and/or third parties may initiate, assist or cooperate with media requests or exposure in connection with any submission(s). Content Provider understands, agrees and assumes the risk that media exposure of his/her submission, if any, may not be the same or commensurate with that of other competing submissions. Content Provider explicitly acknowledges and agrees that the releases given by Content Provider shall cover any claim, expense or liability arising from or relating to such media contact or exposure, or the lack thereof. Content Provider agrees that he/she will not seek media exposure for his/her submission, and he/she will report all requests for interviews or any other direct or indirect media contact to Time for Me TV, LLC for approval, in Producer's sole discretion, prior to participating in any interview or other media contact.

10. Each Content Provider agrees that his/her participation and submission shall be governed by and construed under and in accordance with the laws of the State of Arizona applicable to contracts entered into and wholly performed therein. Each Content Provider consents and agrees to the exclusive jurisdiction and venue of the federal and state courts of the State of Arizona, located in the County of Maricopa.
